Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

"Gaudete in Domino semper" from the Latin Introit for today's Mass on the Third Sunday of Advent, translated to English this reads, "Rejoice in the Lord always!" This Third Sunday of Advent is known as "Gaudete Sunday" and is easily recognized by the rose colored vestments worn by the priest and deacon. There are flowers at the altar which is normally bare during Advent.

St. Paul urges the Christians in Philippi to "Rejoice in the Lord always." This is to be our condition as Christians, a joyful, rejoicing people. We are able to be filled with joy by the presence of the Christ Child who came to earth over two thousand years ago. He still brings joy into the hearts of His faithful people. This is why we celebrate His birthday! He has brought His joy and peace into a world filled with unhappiness and anxiety.

As our Holy Father Pope Benedict the XVI often reminds us, it is a joy and peace that dwells within us not in the world around us. Evil is still in the world and causes continual conflict and absence of external peace. But we as Catholic Christians can be "at peace" in the midst of the conflicted world. This peace does not mean an absence of conflict around us, but rather a peace that dwells within us.

This interior peace from Christ exits in the midst of difficulties. It is compatible with pain, disease, failures and disappointments. This is the great gift of Christmas which we must give thanks to God for bringing from Heaven to earth. This gift of Christ, used faithfully, enables us to have a joyful, peaceful interior road to eternal life.

This beautiful gift also enables us to attract others to Christ and His Church. Our peaceful, joyful life and be an effective advertisement for the Gospel of Jesus Christ. All around us, in our own families, workplaces and friends, people are searching for happiness. We have the answer!
