Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

This Sunday we recall as a Church, the Wedding Feast at Cana, and the amazing Epiphany of the Lord that occurred there at the request of His Mother!

In our Catholic Tradition we have celebrated 3 Epiphanies of the Lord Jesus. His manifestation to the Three Magi Kings, His Manifestation at His Baptism in the River Jordan and His manifestation as God in the miracle of the Wedding Feast of Cana.

In these "Manifestations," the Father keeps showing/telling, in different ways, "this is my Son!" In different circumstances and events the Father is telling us that His Son, Jesus, is amazing, loves us, will use His amazing power to change our lives and will even be willing to suffer and die for us!

Jesus is showing that because of His great love for the Father and us, all that He is, will be available for our good and eternal well being. He will hold nothing back! Nothing of His will be off-limits to us! He will become our very brother, by adoption, through a Covenant signed in His Blood.

Within this simple wedding feast, for poor, working people, the power of the Living God is made manifest. He shows how He has also provided for our needs through the love of His Mother, given as our Mother, from the Cross. Mary, with full confidence, goes to Her Son with our needs, no matter how small or large. Mary does not hesitate to tell the servants, "do as He tells you."

Whenever we come to Mary with a request, she repeats those same words, "do as He tells you." If we follow the instructions of her Son, we too will find our needs met.

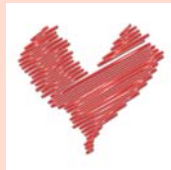

How does Faith Direct work?

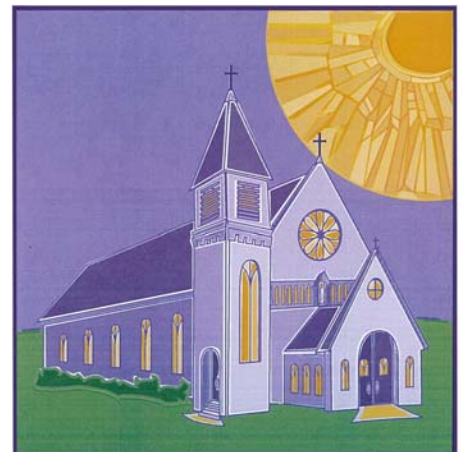
Faith Direct is a secure system that works directly with your bank or credit/debit card –much the same as other direct payments you may have set up for utility bills or mortgage payments.

MASS OFFERINGS AND INTENTIONS IN 2013

Canon #948 of the Code of Canon Law, 1983:

“Separate Masses are to be applied for the intentions for which an individual offering, even if small, has been made and accepted.”

In order to be in compliance with the above Canon Law #948, beginning January 1, 2013, the following guidelines will be followed:

1. Only one intention will be allowed per Mass.
2. Intentions can be for the living or the dead.
3. For a funeral, the immediate family of the deceased will be given seven Mass Intention Envelopes for their use.
4. The parish will offer a Novena of Masses for all other Masses for the deceased as a group, approximately every three months, depending on the number of deaths in the parish. Parishioners will have an unlimited number of offering envelopes available for the Novena of Masses. The names of the deceased will be listed in the bulletin (from the Novena).
5. We will attempt to space the Masses so there will be an opportunity for Mass Intentions during the year for the living and dead. For persons living or not recently deceased, two to three Masses will be scheduled annually (depending on availability of dates) with no limits placed on Novena intentions.
6. The monies from the Novena Masses will be deposited as a General Parish Donation.

The first Novena scheduled for 2013 will begin Monday, February 25th through Tuesday, March 5th.
