Dear St. John and Epiphany Parishioners,

Svatý Cyrila a Metoděje, oroduj za nás! Translated to Eng-  
lish: Saints Cyril and Methodius, pray for us!!!

We began our Novena of Masses to Saints Cyril and Metho-  
dius last Saturday, February 5<sup>th</sup> at the 5:00pm Mass. We con-  
clude our Novena this Sunday at the 10:30am Mass, followed  
by a Procession, with our new Sts. Cyril and Methodius Ban-  
ner, to the KJT Hall for lunch, music and fun!

This occasion celebrates a number of important themes. First  
of all, we are thankful for all of our parishioners of Czech  
heritage that make up our parish! We thank Saint Cyril and  
his brother Saint Methodius for loving their Catholic Faith  
enough to take it to the Slavs. We also praise the Slavic peo-  
ple for being open to the working of the Holy Spirit and ac-  
cepting the gift of Faith that the Lord offered them.

Over a thousand years passed by between the arrival of Saints  
Cyril and Methodius in the Slavic lands and the arrival of our  
Czech parishioners to Ennis, Texas. We know that the new  
immigrants to America relied heavily on the strength of their  
Catholic Faith to enable them to make the journey and forge  
their way in their new country. Unlike those who landed on  
the Eastern shores of America, those who came to Texas did  
not find many fellow Catholics. Therefore, it fell on them to  
build churches and schools in order to practice their Faith and  
pass it on to their children.

We ask Saints Cyril and Methodius to intercede to the Lord  
for us that we might have a Catholic Faith strong enough to  
enable us to continue and build on the Faith they brought to  
the Slavic peoples.

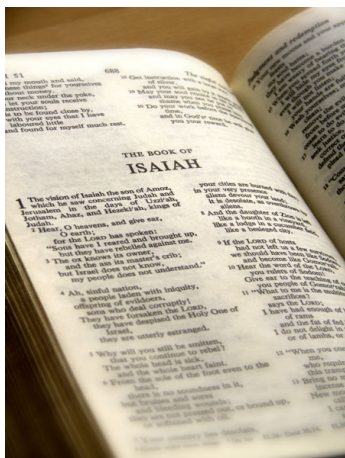

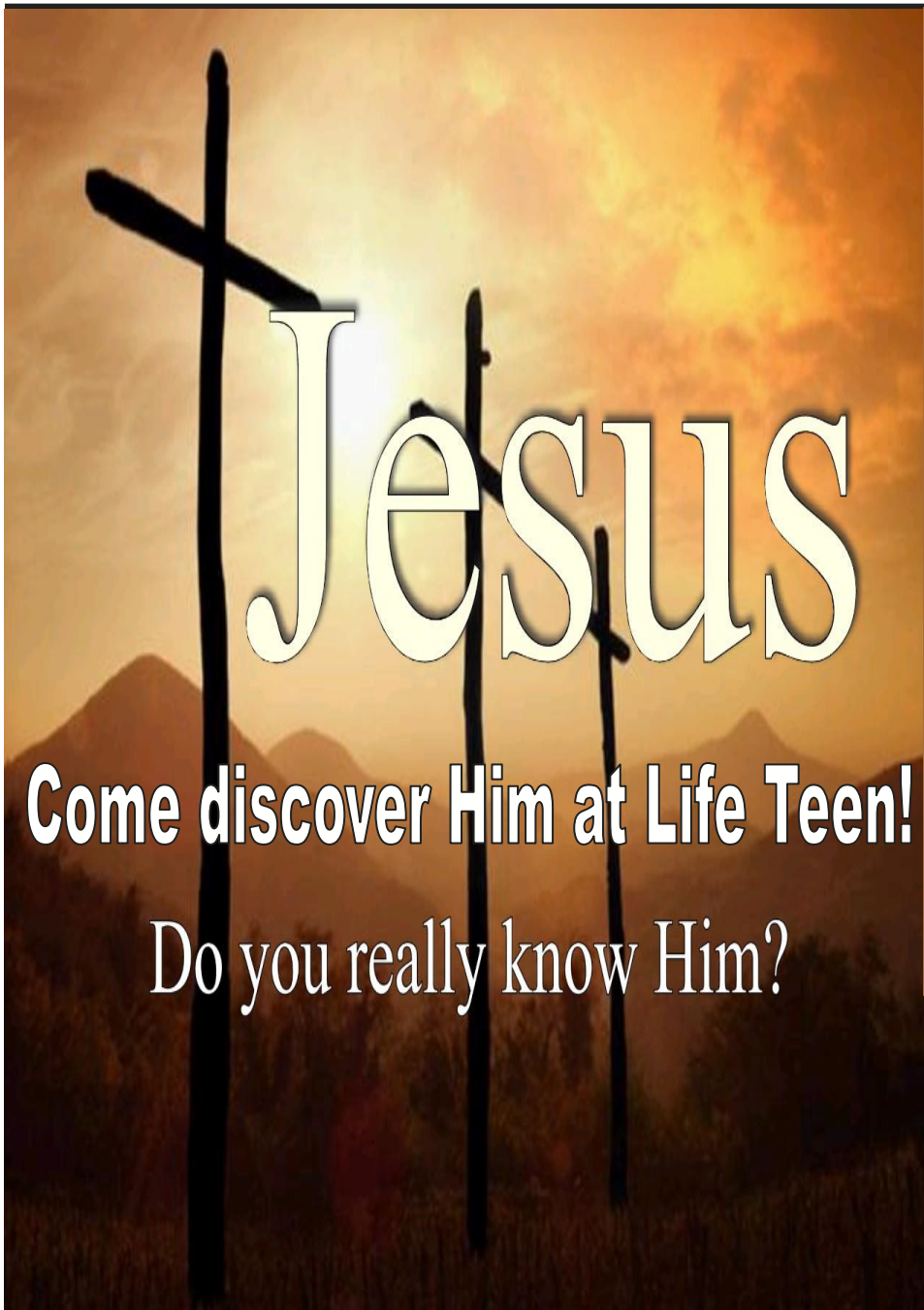
