PLENARY INDULGENCE for attending a Parish Mission

A *Plenary Indulgence* is granted the Christian faithful who on the occasion of a Mission hear some of the sermons and are present for its solemn conclusion.*

"In offering the gift of an indulgence they intend to lead the Christian faithful to perform works of devotion, charity, and penitence and to aid them by means of charity to closer

union with the body of the Church and with Christ, its head."**

*The Handbook of Indulgences Norms and Grants (41)

This Sunday is traditionally called *Laetare Sunday* from the opening words of the Entrance Antiphon. The strictness of the Lenten liturgy is interrupted on this Sunday with words that speak to us of **JOY**. Today, rose-colored vestments, if they are available are permitted in place of purple, and the altar can be decked with flowers as on no other day in Lent. In this way the Church wishes to remind us that

JOY is perfectly compatible with mortification and pain. It is *sadness* and not penance which is opposed to happiness.

Taking part to the utmost in this liturgical season which reaches its climax in the Passion, and hence in suffering, we realize that approaching the Cross also means that the moment of our Redemption is coming ever closer.

In this way, the Church and each of her children are filled with joy:

Rejoice with Jerusalem and be glad for her, all you who love her. 18 66:10


