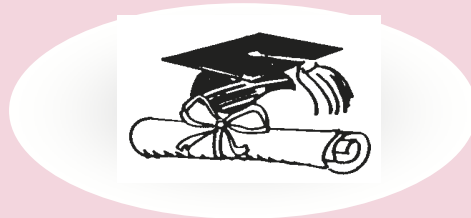

THANK YOU TO BARTO FAMILY

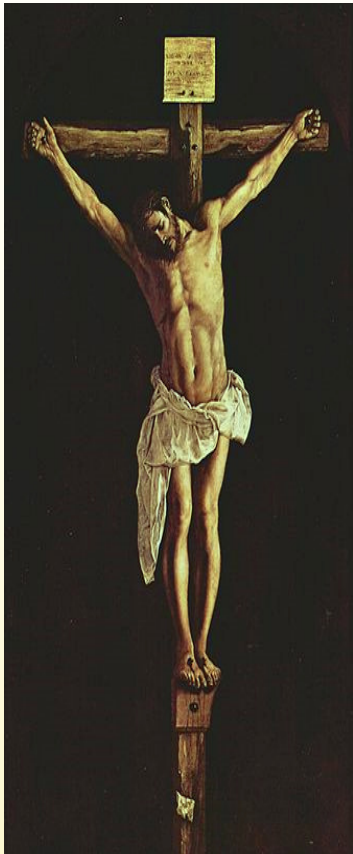
