Well, folks, we have completed our Easter Season and are beginning the Ninth Week in Ordinary Time.

However, for us as Catholic Christians, time is never "ordinary." For us who are baptized into the life of the Most Holy Trinity, each day can be amazing and awesome, never ordinary. We are created in the image of our God who is a trinity of three persons. This trinity consists of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
