from the Pastor's desk

Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

I am writing this message from the 2011 Convocation of Priests in the Diocese of Dallas being held in Westlake, Texas. We just concluded our daily Eucharistic Liturgy with our Bishop, Kevin Farrell, and his two auxiliary Bishops, Doug Deshotel and Mark Seitz. It is always a very powerful experience to concelebrate the Holy Mass with the Bishop and all the priests of the Diocese.

However, I found it especially moving as we are drawing near to our celebration of the Feast of Pentecost, the coming of the Holy Spirit and the birth of our Holy Catholic Church. This same Holy Spirit descended upon the first Pope, St. Peter and his Bishops gathered around him. As we bring a close to our Easter Season this weekend, let this "closing," be like the "close" or death of our mortal life, let it be a birth into a more vibrant life in Christ. I pray the Easter graces we have been receiving here at St. John and Epiphany will have strengthened and enlivened our spiritual life. I pray that we all have a better understanding of what Easter means to us. I pray that we will live different lives because of this Easter Season and go on to experience the gifts of the Holy Spirit in our daily lives with our families, fellow workers, parishioners and all those we meet.


