**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,  
Jesus asked, "Which of them will love him more?"

This is a very powerful question, especially after our Parish Celebration and Procession for the Feast of Corpus Christi last weekend. When we personally encountered the risen Christ in our humanity and brokenness, we suddenly realize how great a love He has for each of us.

As we celebrated the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass together, and Jesus became present on our altar with us and then walked with us in procession, we were able to experience the real "flesh and blood" love He has for us.

As we were under the tent, feeling the Texas heat and humidity, then processing in the Texas sun, we could in a physical way relate to Jesus' love for each of us personally. He came to this earth and took on our flesh so He could feel what we feel...hunger, pain, sweat, sunburn, tiredness, etc... and yet His love is so great that He never says to us that it is too hot, or He is too tired. He only comes to love us when we call Him.

Jesus does notice who truly loves Him with their actions and not just their words. He said to the Pharisee, "When I entered your house, you did not give me water for my feet. You did not anoint my head with oil. So I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven because she has shown a great love."

Those are the words that we want Jesus to be able to say about each of us, every day of our lives.

I am very proud of all our folks who came, even though they weren't sure what was going on. Who came even though it was hot. Who came even though the walk was hotter.

Jesus will say that we showed Him a great love!

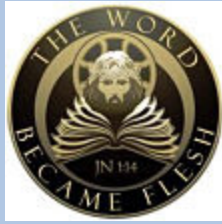
