Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

Jesus in our Gospel Reading today speaks those powerful and scary words, "If anyone wishes to come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will save it."

These two sentences, when unpacked, lay out for us our entire Catholic life. In the Paschal Mystery, the suffering, death and resurrection of Christ, our focus has moved from this world to the Kingdom of God. Jesus left us our Church as the means of salvation. Our Church provides the road map, the fuel and the vehicle to take us all the way to the Kingdom of God in Heaven. That is why our Faith must become our Life. That is why we are here in Church. That is why we must have a daily prayer life. That is why we must use the Sacraments of Confession and Eucharist as often as possible. That is why we must study the Scripture and Catechism. That is why we must read the lives of the Saints. That is why we must imitate the lives of the Saints. That is why we are Catholic!
