Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

Here we are right in the middle of the HOT days of a Texas summer! I pray everyone is taking the necessary precautions to avoid health problems from the heat; shady, cool and hydrated environments!

Our current climate adds a particular realism to the Gospel Parable Jesus uses in this Sunday's Liturgy. Jesus says, ". . . when the sun rose it was scorched and it withered for lack of roots." Not too hard to imagine, right! All you have to do is step outside and look at what used to be your green grass or flowers! Sort of scorched and withered!

This might also be what Jesus sees, many times, when He looks down from Heaven at each one of us. He sees that our Catholic life has been scorched by temptation and sin with the result that it has withered. Some times it has only withered a little, like droopy flowers, other times with the effect of mortal sins it has withered to the point of spiritual death.

Like the lawn and flower beds, if we go a period of time without life-giving water/grace it dies and is much more difficult to bring back to life. That is why we need to make regular prayer time, examination of conscience, frequent Confession and Eucharist the rule of our lives. We as Roman Catholics have the necessary tools and tradition to counteract the times of temptation and sin. We have the gifts of the Sacraments, especially Confession and Eucharist. We also have over 2000 years of spiritual guidance and tradition from the Saints who have gone before us and set a good example of how to maintain our spiritual lawns and flower beds of holiness!

Speaking of that.....See you in the Confessional and at Mass!
