Pastor's Message

Fifteenth Sunday In Ordinary Time + 2014

Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

Our Gospel this Sunday is a familiar one, the parable of the Sower and the Seeds. This parable, along with about six others, is found in the thirteenth chapter of St. Matthew's Gospel. Many Scripture scholars call this Chapter Thirteen, "parable discourse" or the "parabolic discourse". These parables all deal with descriptions of the Kingdom of Heaven and we folks who are trying to get there.

Several features of this highly desirable Kingdom are emphasized in the parables: the humble, small beginning of the Kingdom on earth; God will continue to steadily grow it; it is universal (catholic); and it is very powerful and able to save each one of us!

The kicker in today's parable is the basic truth that not only does God love us, but He also respects our freedom to choose and act. We can decide "NO" and "DO NOTHING" that God teaches us. We are completely free! Also, we learn we are not alone with God in this field, but there is another "one" whose purpose is evil and dedicated to destroying our very lives for all eternity. So this means that tending this "field" can be hard, tedious work and include suffering.

St. Paul, in his letter to the folks in Rome, tries to encourage the Romans and us, telling us that "the sufferings of this present time are as nothing compared with the glory to be revealed for us. . . all creation is groaning in labor pains even until now."

So, let's all get back down on our knees and work and sweat in this field for an abundant harvest!
