On the Feast Day of St. Mary Magdalene we consider *the intensity of the love burning in the heart of the woman who did not leave the tomb, although the disciples had already gone away. She continued to see the one she had failed to find. She sought for him in tears and, inflamed with the fire of love, was burning with longing to see the One she thought they had taken away. Because Mary Magdalene remained there with the expectation of finding him, she was the only one to encounter Him. Perseverance strengthens good deeds and as the voice of Truth informs us: "Whoever perseveres to the end will be saved."* Let us not stop seeking Jesus in every circumstance of our lives; even during those moments in which, if the Lord so permits, discouragement or darkness penetrate our soul. Let us never forget that he is always very much in touch with the vents of our life though we may not be aware of him. He is always close at hand, for as the Apostle assures us - *'Dominus prope est!' - the Lord is near. I shall walk with him, therefore, quite confidently, for the Lord is my Father... and with his help I shall fulfill his most loveable Will, even if I find it hard.*

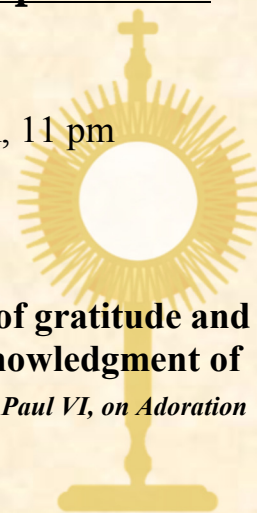

Altar Server Commitments

- ♦ Serve Mass at your scheduled day/time.
- ♦ Arrive in the Sacristy at least 15 minutes early.
- ♦ Post a sub request on MSP if you are unable to serve your scheduled Mass.
- ♦ Attend Altar Server Training sessions
- ♦ Receive the Sacrament of Confession regularly to be in a State of Grace for receiving Holy Communion

Altar Server Scholarship Program

- ♦ Under 40 points in good standing for the year = \$125.00 credit
- ♦ 40 points in Calendar Year = \$375.00 credit
- ♦ Over 50 points in Calendar Year = \$425.00 credit
- ♦ 1 point per scheduled served Mass
- ♦ Points for Special Events will be announced
- ♦ Posting a Sub Request on MSP you will receive a 1/2 point
- ♦ Substitute will receive 1 point
- ♦ Extra Server at Mass will receive 1/4 point
- ♦ HS Graduate servers for over 25 points = \$500 per year—up to two years

Receiving the Scholarship

- ♦ Following completion of 4 High School Years of Altar Serving in good standing.
- ♦ Scholarship check will be presented to Altar Server in his name if over 18 or to parent/legal guardian if under 18 years old.
