Because Mary Magdalene remined there with the expectation of finding him, shew as the only one to them encounter Him. Perseverance strengthens good deeds and as the voice of Truth informs us: "Whoever perseveres to the end will be saved." Let us not stop seeking Jesus in every circumstance of our lives; even during those moments in which, if the Lord so permits, discouragement or darkness penetrate our soul. Altar Server Scholarship Program

- Under 40 points in good standing for the year = \$125.00 credit
- 40 points in Calendar Year = \$375.00 credit
- Over 50 points in Calendar Year = \$425.00 credit
- 1 point per scheduled served Mass
- Points for Special Events will be announced
- Posting a Sub Request on MSP you will receive a 1/2 point
- Substitute will receive 1 point
- Extra Server at Mass will receive 1/4 point
- HS Graduate servers for over 25 points = \$500 per year—up to two years

Receiving the Scholarship

- Following completion of 4 High School Years of Altar Serving in good standing.
- Scholarship check will be presented to Altar Server in his name if over 18 or to parent/legal guardian if under 18 years old.
