Pastor's Message

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
+ 2014

Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

What an amazing Spring and Summer, so far! The rainfall and temperature have been a great blessing from our Lord. We thank Him for all the good that He does for us. In fact, each of the Eucharistic Prayers, other than Eucharistic Prayer II, concludes with this statement: “. . . you bestow on the world all that is good.”

Since our God is all Good, only Good can come from Him. The theological definition of evil is: an absence of Good. Truth, God's Truth, is all good. This is why we seek out His Truth. If we do not know the Truth we cannot live according to the Truth. Even in secular circumstances, the truth is also important. To correctly operate a machine, new iPhone or software, we must know and understand the truth of how it is to function. Without this knowledge of truth, the item will not be able to produce the desired results. Our use of the machine or whatever, will be a failure.

This can be applied to every part of our lives. Our loving Father sent His Word of Truth, Jesus Christ, to earth to give us the “Gospel Truth.” He was tired of watching us try to live our lives according to the lies of the Devil and seeing the hurt and destruction caused by the use of lies. This applies from our individual life to the life of entire nations and our planet Earth.

Our Gospel today, speaks of this from Jesus' lips in the form of another Parable from Matthew Chapter 13. The Parable of the Wheat and Cockles! Cockles are a plant that is indistinguishable from wheat until they are both fully grown. Cockles are toxic to humans and therefore, if sown in with the wheat will ruin the entire harvest. Enemy armies would sow cockles in their opponent's fields, thus depriving them of their wheat crop and food.

The Devil, very cleverly, sows his lies which are made to sound good and reasonable in with God's Truth. But the lies will cause failure. Most often in our culture, the lies are hidden in the seemingly good plots of movies, inspiring lyrics and life advice from experts.

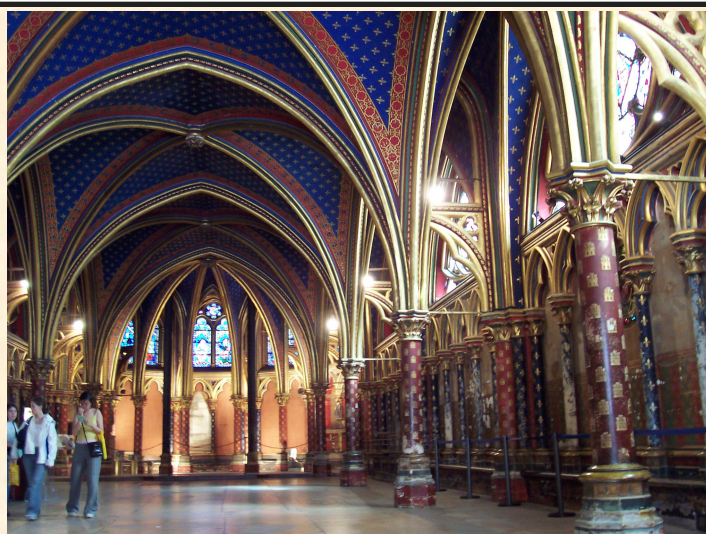
