#### **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time + 2017

Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

We continue to hear the Gospel by Saint Matthew. We have been hearing the series of Jesus descriptions of the Kingdom of Heaven. Based on these descriptions, Jesus teaches us how to be people of the Kingdom of God and not people of the Kingdom of the Evil One.

As we know, Jesus came to earth to do the will of the Father. The Father wants all of His children, each and every one of us to spend eternity in Heaven with Him. Jesus, His only Son, paid the price for our entrance into the Kingdom of God.

The first description of the Kingdom of God which begins here on earth is that of a wheat field where the farmer has sown the good wheat seed for his future bread. But the farmer's enemy snuck in during the night and sowed cockleseed in the farmer's wheat field. This was a common tactic used by a countries' enemies. When the two plants first grow, you cannot tell them apart. When they are mature the cockle is poisonous to humans and if mixed with flour will ruin the bread.

Jesus uses this example to warn us of people who will teach false doctrine about our Catholic Faith. What they teach, at first, sounds good and true but if allowed to continue and grow in us, will lead us to sin and separate us from Jesus.

This is a very relevant teaching for us today in the year 2017. Many people try to slightly change our Catholic Faith, and at first, it doesn't seem bad. But if the error is allowed to be lived out in our lives, will actually harm our Faith and lead us away from the love of Jesus.

When we hear something "new" we need to be careful and listen to what the Church says about this "new" way of living our Catholic Faith. Jesus left us the Church to protect us from the "cockles" of our time.


