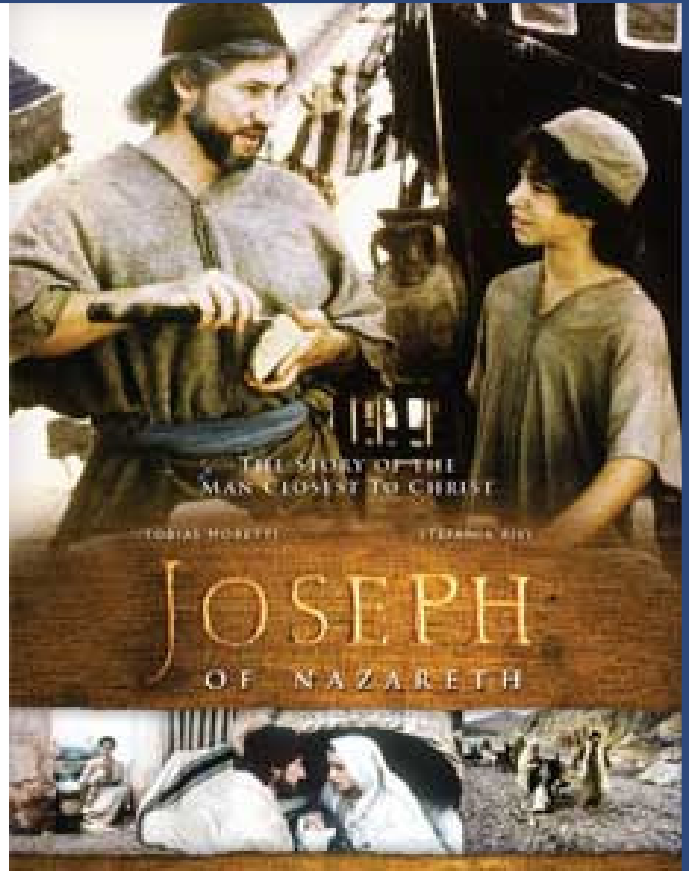
## St. John Nepomucene Movie Night
