Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

"Peter said to Him in reply, 'Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water."

I suppose the first thought that came to my mind was a choice between two options as to the intent of Peter's words to Jesus. Could this have been said in the manner of a "smart aleck?" Could Peter have thought, 'sure Jesus, you are walking on water, (probably standing on something in the water), but I will play along, so....if that is true, then make me walk on water, too!

However, the more I thought and prayed about this passage from Matthew's Gospel, the more I realized that Peter was very serious. After all, they were in the middle of a storm, they were very concerned for their own safety, so I believe their general attitude would have been serious. Also, St. Matthew is retelling this event, not as a joke, but as a teaching of faith for us.

When Jesus responded to Peter's request, with the one word, "Come," Peter with a strong and immediate faith, "...got out of the boat and began to walk on the water toward Jesus." What faith! It worked! He was actually walking on water! Then Peter allowed fear and doubt to creep in and began to sink. Even then, Jesus shows us just what kind of a God He is! He is the kind that never gives up on us no matter how many times we give up, lose faith, and doubt in Him. Of course, as soon as we begin to "sink" like Peter, we once again holler for help, "Lord, save me!" As today's Scripture tells us, Jesus immediately stretches out His hand to save us again, and again, and again, and again!

This is why we are in Church as often as possible to worship and praise Him. He is such a great God! He more than deserves all our adoration! He is an awesome God!
