Why would so many young women take vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience?

In 1997, four Dominican sisters started a new foundation called Mary, Mother of the Eucharist. In the 15 years since then, the group has grown to over 100 sisters. The average age of all the sisters is 28, and the average age of the women who enter the group is 21.

Why have they grown so quickly?

Why are so many young women embracing this life?

What makes them willing to vow to be poor, to be celibate, and to obey someone else for the rest of their lives?

These kinds of questions led Oprah to invite the Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist on her show twice, on February 9 and November 23, 2010.

We'll have the opportunity to hear their answers to these kinds of questions and to learn from their journeys when they come here to St. John Nepomucene. One of the founders and 4 novices will be coming here in September. They will be at the Sunday Masses on Sept. 9 and will give talks on the evenings of Sept. 10 and 11.


