Date of Profession: April 4, 1983 *Her Testimony:* I felt the call to religious life at the age of seven, but I did not fully understand it. I just knew I would never get married. I trusted that convicting word and took the step in faith to join the Disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ. Now, after 30 years of religious life, I can say God has been very true to His promise. I have never been happier! *Favorite Quote:* "I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall be continually in my mouth." (Ps. 34:1)
