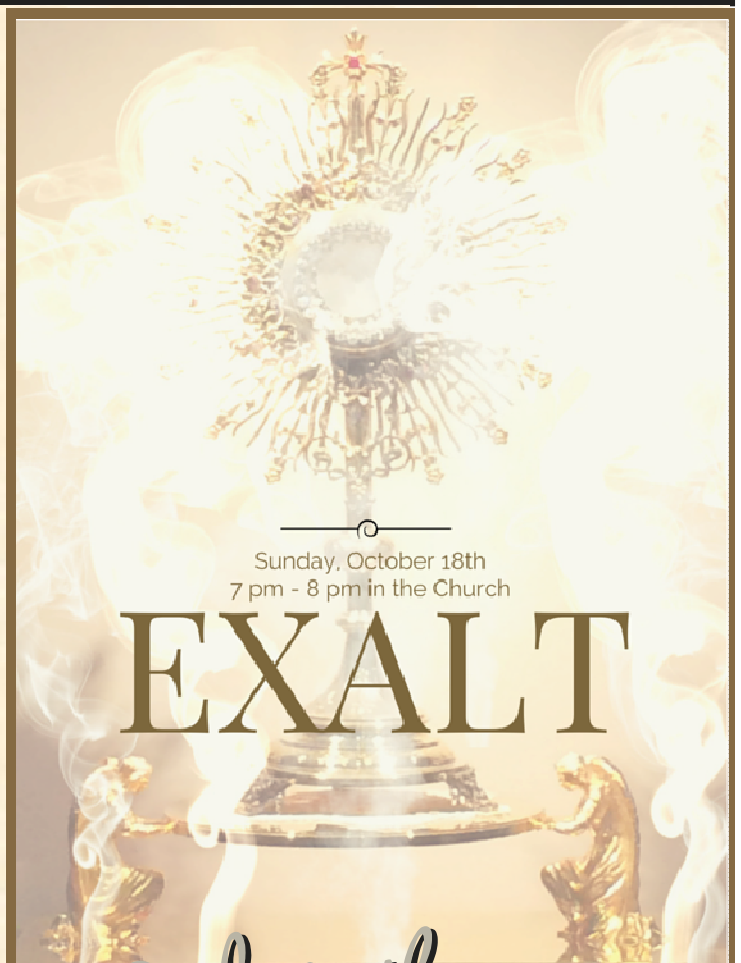

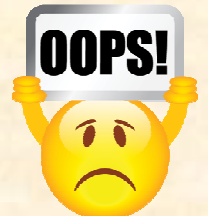

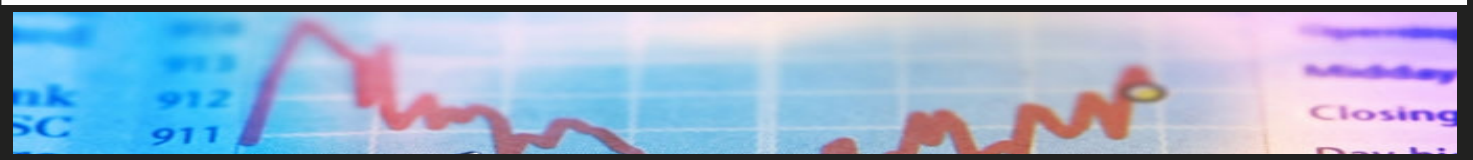
Thanks to your contributions in the last year we have been able to accomplish many great things in our parish family, including:
