Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,
Our first reading ends with the sentence: "His dominion is an everlasting dominion, that shall not be taken away, His kingship shall not be destroyed."

Jesus Himself, ends our second reading by saying, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, says the Lord God, the one who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty." And again, in our Gospel for this weekend, "You say I am a king. For this I was born and for this I came into the world. . . ."

As we end our Liturgical Year, Mother Church reminds us of the end of time. Our Lord came into our world to begin a Kingdom that will come to its completion upon His Second Coming. He told Pilate in today's Gospel that His Kingdom does not belong to this world. His Kingdom exists here only in His faithful, you and me. We chose to begin living here on earth, as if we are living in His Kingdom in Heaven.

What Jesus is promising us that He will do.....is too hard to believe. He has promised that He will come back to Earth, the Dead will rise from their graves, and He will take all His faithful followers to a new place to live forever, that will be perfect.

If we have already died, we will get a perfect body back and then live in a new place just as we had been trying to live as Christians, but all the bad will not exist. Think of it! Living just like today, but a perfect body in perfect health, no worries, no one who hates us, no one being mean or selfish.....just perfect!

Too good to be true! We must ask Him for the Faith to believe! He made good on His first promise to come to earth.He will keep His second promise!

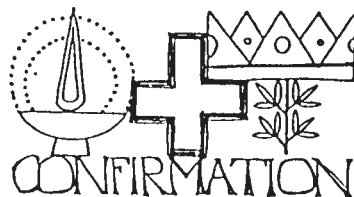

CHARITABLE DONATIONS FOR 2012

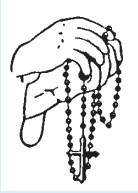
