Pastor's Message

Second Sunday of Ordinary Time
+ 2016

Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

Here we are already finishing our first week in Ordinary Time following our Christmas Season. For me, Advent and Christmas were blessed seasons. Each year the Lord takes me to a new place, closer to Him as the graces flow from our Liturgical Seasons. It is a beautiful and practical gift from our Mother, our Church.

We are now reading the Gospels of Jesus' public life. This Sunday we hear proclaimed the public manifestation of His glory at the wedding feast in the town of Cana. Even though the timing was not opportune, as He points out to His Mother....nevertheless, He responds to her request for the need of her children. In this response, the miracle of water to wine, He reveals His glory, majesty, power and humble love for us.

This Gospel reading set the stage and pattern for our daily lives. Whether we are at work, school, attending a wedding or just around the house, we live a life patterned after Our Lord and His Mother. We are to be aware always of the needs of others and responding to their need, even when they don't ask. At the Wedding Feast of Cana, someone pointed out the lack of wine, but no one had to ask for a remedy.

Many times, like Cana, our response can be practical, but many times prayer is the best, most powerful and always effective means of loving others in whatever situation.



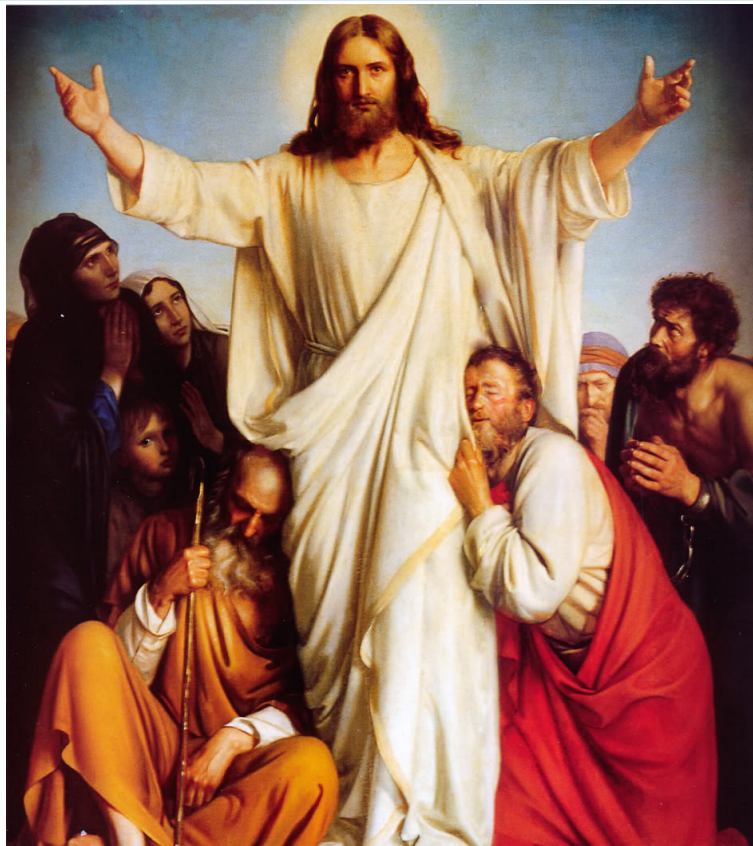
