- If we receive a gift with a check dated 12/31/2016, but the postmark of the envelope reads 1/1/2017 (or later) then it will be posted as a gift received in 2017.

We will also record all hand delivered gifts received at the office on **Dec. 31, 2016 by noon** as a 2016 gift.

St. Joseph Cemetery Entrance Project

The St. Joseph Cemetery Committee would like to update you on changes that will occur on a section of land adjacent to the cemetery. Apartments will be built on north side of the cemetery.

The City of Ennis had designated this section of land as a commercial zone 40 years ago, and development will begin approx. the end of January 2017. To accommodate the project, the apartment complex owner/developers gave requested that we release the easement of the current cemetery entrance and instead use a new entrance from Jeter Drive that they will build.

- **1.** The new entrance and street will be concrete, 24' wide to the first intersection.
- 2. The small section of land from Jeter Drive to the cemetery boundary will be deeded to St. Joseph Cemetery.
- **3.** A new "St. Joseph Cemetery" entrance arch similar to the one we currently have will be constructed and erected with new columns and walls.
- 4. The front entrance will be landscaped with different shrubs and a water sprinkler system will be installed.

5. The new gate will continue to open and close automatically.

6. A six foot wrought iron fence will be erected on the north side of the cemetery from the new entrance along the three sides facing the apartments.


7. There will be no added expense (except attorney fees) for the exchange and revision of the entrance to the St. Joseph Cemetery or St. John Nepomucene Catholic Church.

SAFETY ISSUES: During the construction of the new drive, trucks and tractors will be coming and going into the job site. We ask that you do not park cars near the construction site nor walk in this area.

Representatives from the St. Joseph Cemetery Committee will be in the Cafeteria after each Mass (5 pm Saturday, 12/10 and 7am & 11am Sunday, 12/11) to answer any questions. Also, there will be a sketch of the proposed new entrance and a full survey of the cemetery for anyone to view.
