WINTER WALKERS



- If we receive a gift with a check dated 12/31/2016 on 1/3/2016, but the postmark on the envelope reads 12/31/2016 (or earlier) then we will post the date of the gift as 12/31/2016.
- If we receive a gift with a check dated 12/31/2016, but the postmark of the envelope reads 1/1/2017 (or later) then it will be posted as a gift received in 2017.

We will also record all hand delivered gifts received at the office on Dec. 31, 2016 by noon as a 2016 gift.


