St. John Nepomucene ORGAN REBUILD Project



The funds from the campaign will be used to rebuild and refurbish the organ console and switching system.

The organ console will be removed from the choir loft by C. Bobsin Organ builders of San Antonio.

The organ console/keyboards will be fully rebuilt. New keyboards, MIDI, Record & Playback, Transpose and many other accessory items will be included in the electronic systems.

All interior switching and control systems will be replaced along with all the existing wiring.

All new stop controls and a new combination actions would be added to the console. The pedalboard would receive a full rebuild with new felts, bushings and contacts.

The complete project cost estimate is \$49,000 – \$50,000.

Please contribute so we can continue to enjoy the beautiful music of our pipe organ during our Masses and Liturgies here at St. John Nepomucene.
