Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

We have completed with joy and power our journey through Easter Season. Our Grand Finale was last weekend celebrating the Coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost!

We have now entered the Liturgical Season of Ordinary Time. This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of The Most Holy Trinity, our God, one incredible God in three Persons; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This amazing God who has chosen us to be His own people, now entrusts us with His very life. We are commanded to go out and bring others into His family by baptism and teaching the Gospel way of life.

“Moses says to the people: . . . **Did anything so great ever happen before? Was it ever head of?”**


