Who can Reserve a Room?

The rooms and facilities of St. John Nepomucene are available for use by groups and organizations which support and further the mission of St. John Nepomucene.

- No group is entitled to a room
- Reservation and use of rooms is subject to the discretion of the pastor
- Conflicts between events or meetings are resolved by the pastor
- At the discretion of the pastor, events may be cancelled even after they have been reserved and are on the parish calendar

How to Reserve a Room

- 1. To reserve a room on campus for your organization or group, fill out a Facilities Use Request Form
 - The Facilities Use Request Form may be obtained at the parish office or on the parish website
 - This form should be turned in to the parish office at least one week before the desired usage date, two weeks is better
- 2. When usage has been approved, your event will appear on the parish calendar
 - The parish calendar may be found on the parish website or the parish app
 - If it is not on the calendar, it is not approved
 - If it is not on the calendar, do not expect to meet
 - Check the calendar the day of your event. If your event is not on the calendar, do not meet.

Summer Usage

- No evening events will be scheduled during the week of Vacation Bible School. Normal weekly events will be cancelled that week.
- No meetings or events will be held on the St.
 John Nepomucene campus during the first two
 weeks of July for waxing and yearly
 maintenance to occur.
- Events and meetings will be confined to the compound through July and into August.

St. John Nepomucene Room Usage Policy

How to use a room

Compound Key Card System

- If you are using a compound room that uses the electronic key card system, make sure that you pick up the key card at the office.
- Your key card will open your room and the restroom and the room adjacent to your room which has the heat and air controls if necessary.
- Key cards are normally programmed to work from one hour before until one hour after your event.
- Keep your key card. It should work each time your event is planned. After your event or series is over, keep your key card. It will no longer work, but it can be reactivated by the office when you plan a new event.

Mechanical Keys

- If the room you are using is not one of the compound rooms that uses the electronic key card system, you will need to pick up the key for your room at the parish office.
- There are a limited number of keys, so you will check out the key before your event and return it to the parish office after your event.
- Even if you have the same event the next week, return your key, and check one out again the next week.

Set up and clean up

- If you want something specific in the room or a specific set up for the room you reserve, make sure to request that on the Facilities Use Request and then check that it is listed on the description of your event on the parish calendar.
- If you bring food to your meeting, please remove all food and trash before you leave.
