PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time+ 2018

Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

Last weekend we celebrated in a special way the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. That source of strength and grace we need to fight the effects of Original Sin that we hear in our first reading from the Book of Genesis. The book of the beginning of God's plan here on earth.

Our Father in Heaven created the first human beings, male and female, endowed with intelligence and will in order offer to God a glory that no other creature could offer. God gave to Adam and Eve supernatural graces and virtues. He filled them with sanctifying grace. The lived in a state of holiness and justice and had the power to live a supernatural life here on earth.

God gave to Adam and Eve what are termed, preternatural gifts: immunity from death, from the inclination to sin and from ignorance. These gifts they would have transmitted as an inheritance to their children and then to all generations. Instead, because of their choice to ignore God's love and to sin, they transmitted to their children an inheritance of the disorder of sin. The very first offspring of Adam and Eve, their sons, committed the first murder. Cain killing his own brother, Abel, out of jealousy.

Now we each are born with this inheritance of sin. Each one of us is born broken by sin. This sin is forgiven in Baptism, but the effects of the sin, our inheritance from our first parents remains with us, the fruit of their life of earth. We lost all of the good inheritance our parents could have passed on to us, but they lost because of their sin.

Now each of us must build a new inheritance while here on earth by choosing to live in the grace of our Baptism and thus rebuild the inheritance our parents lost. Let's do it! Together as Church!
