Summer is a time for a break in hectic schedules, more sunshine, and hopefully a few days off. Here are few ideas to help your family keep the Faith on Vacation!

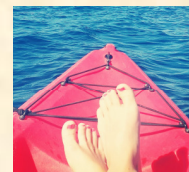


PRAY THE ROSARY

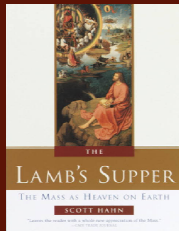

All teens, incoming freshman—graduated seniors are encourage to come to the summer kick-off & take part in all this summer has to offer with their Youth Group.



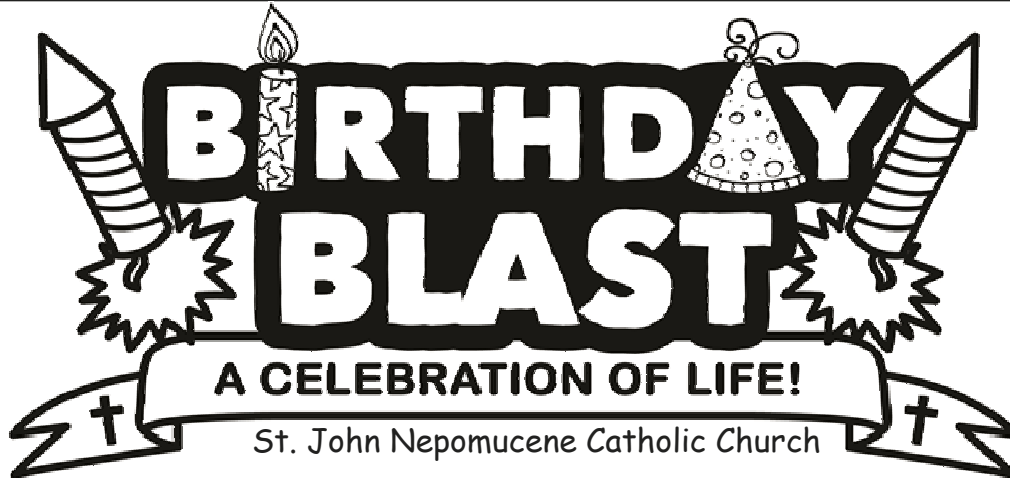
