OFFICIAL PRAYER FOR WORLD YOUTH DAY 2016

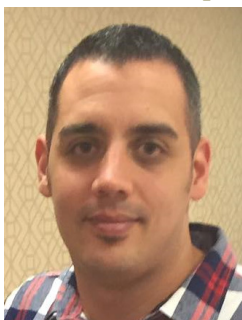

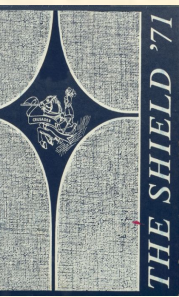
