Pastor's Message

Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time  
+ 2015

Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

Last Sunday we began hearing the Gospel proclaimed from the Gospel of Saint John, Chapter Six. We will continue reading from Chapter Six for the next 3 Sundays. In these five Gospel readings Jesus establishes Himself as the Son of God and the Bread of Life.

He also takes the People of God on a new journey from the Old Covenant to the New Covenant. He begins to move them from a Faith based in this earthly world to a Faith that will take them "out of this world."

He reveals to us that the Blessing the Father is going to bestow on His children through His Son is greater than anything that has happened before in history. It is greater and more amazing than the Passover from slavery in Egypt to the Promised Land. It is greater than the manna that He gave them to eat in the desert. It is greater than the blessing of health, wealth and security that was given to the righteous on earth.

This last Wednesday, July 29, we celebrated the Feast Day of Saint Martha. She, along with her brother Lazarus and her sister Mary were beloved friends of Jesus here on earth. He often visited them and stayed at their home. We are familiar with account of Jesus being called to their home in Bethany because Lazarus was dying. We know that Jesus delayed his visit and by the time He arrived, Lazarus was already dead.

Jesus uses this opportunity to teach and show that He has the power to raise the dead to life again. He shows in a practical way the future of the Resurrection of the Body and Life Eternal for each one of us.

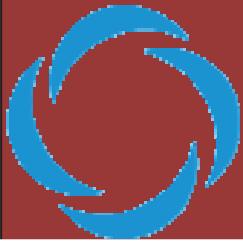
